The student conference is a research forum where talented graduate and undergraduate students from various universities in the Rocky Mountain region present water/wastewater related projects. Above all, this conference connects academia and industry through networking among students, engineering and consulting firms, local utilities, university faculty, and more. We encourage a broad range of student research topics including the following:

Students have traditionally presented in oral and poster presentation formats throughout the conference.

- (2) Student Poster Presentations: Standard research poster. Maximum size 4ft x 4ft.
